Pray'r and good works will fill ev - 'ry day.




At that last hour, Sav - ior, oh place us

Give us Your grace to have the right spir - it,




At your right hand! O God, hear our call!

Prokeimenon of Meatfare Sunday - Tone 3 (Psalm 146:5,1):

Great is our Lord and great is his pow - er. His un - der - stand - ing
is with - out meas - ure.

Verse: Praise the Lord, for a psalm is good. May praise delight our God.

Immediately after the verse:

Prokeimenon of the Saint - Tone 1 (Psalm 48:4,2):

My lips will speak words of wis - dom;
un - der - stand - ing will be the theme of my heart.

Alleluia of Meatfare Sunday - Tone 8 (Psalm 94:1,2):
