
Kontakion of the Cross - Tone 7

those in Ha - des: En - ter a - gain in - to par - a - dise.



Prokeimenon of the Cross - Tone 6 (Psalm 27:9,1):




Save your peo - ple, O Lord, and bless your in - her - i - tance,
