


Of all the proph - ets who fore - told God's hid - den plan of grace,

E - li - jah, proph - et of your Name! We praise you ev - er - more,





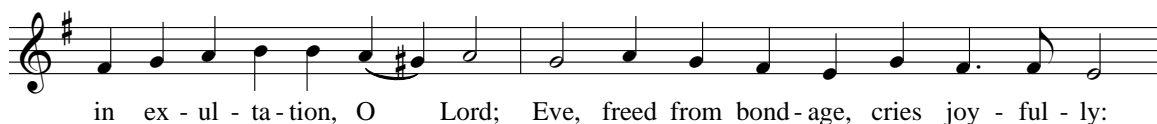
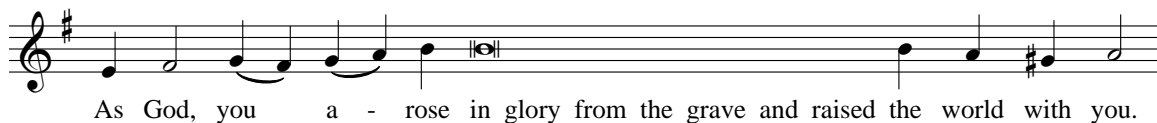
An an-gel in the flesh, the foundation of the proph - ets, and the sec-ond

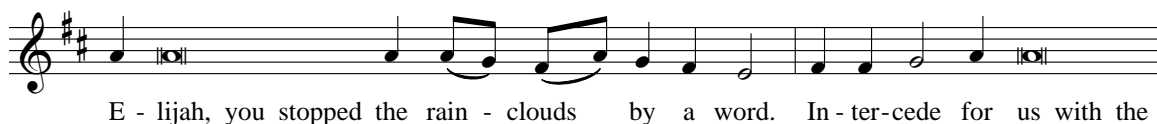
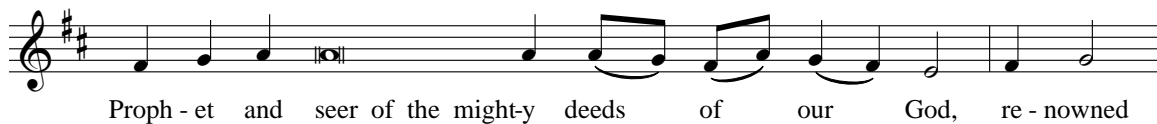
