Faith, as might-y shield, won't to e - vil yield; Gos-pel's zeal as stur-dy shoe!

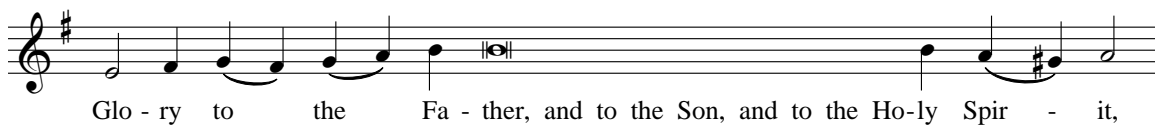

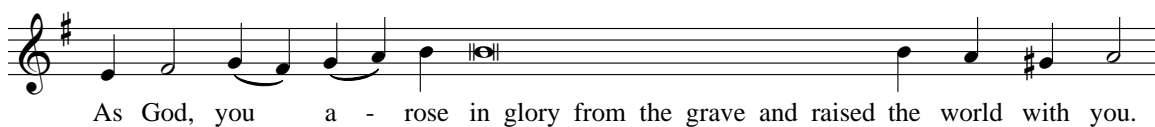
