

Our Christ makes haste to come now and brings us back to grace.




Whose cov - e - nant with God en - dured, we give You praise, in - deed!



Kontakion of the Pre-feast - Tone 3


To - day the Vir-gin is com-ing to the cave to give birth to

Alleluia - Tone 4 (Psalm 43:2,8):






Cherubic Hymn
