

TYPIKA AT HOME: DECEMBER 6, 2021  
FEAST OF OUR HOLY FATHER NICHOLAS THE WONDER-WORKER, ARCHBISHOP  
OF MYRA IN LYCIA

**Troparion, Tone 4:**

Your life has shown you to your flock as a rule of faith, an image of gentleness, and a teacher of moderation. You acquired greatness through humility and wealth through poverty. O Father and Archbishop Nicholas, intercede with Christ our God to save our souls.

*The following is then read:*

On December 6, we commemorate our father among the saints, Nicholas, Archbishop of Myra in Lycia, the Wonderworker.

On earth he was the high priest in Myra; in heaven he is our spokesman before God. It was on the sixth day of the month of December that Nicholas completed his earthly sojourn.

Through his holy prayers, O our God, have mercy on us and save us. Amen.

*Leader:* Through the prayers of our holy fathers, O Lord Jesus Christ our God, have mercy on us.

*Response:* Amen.

Glory to you, our God, glory to you.

Heavenly King, Comforter, Spirit of Truth, everywhere present and filling all things, Treasury of blessings and Giver of Life, come and dwell within us, cleanse us of all stain, and save our souls, O gracious One.

Holy God, Holy and Mighty, Holy and Immortal, have mercy on us. (*Three times*)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and forever. Amen.

Most Holy Trinity, have mercy on us; Lord, cleanse us of our sins; Master, forgive our transgressions; Holy One, come to us and heal our infirmities for your name's sake.

Lord, have mercy. (*Three times*)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and forever. Amen.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

*Leader:* Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us.

**Response:** Amen.

The Lord has set his throne in heaven  
and his kingdom is ruling over all.

mighty in power, fulfilling his word,  
who heed the voice of his word.

Bless the Lord, all his hosts,  
his servants who do his will.

Bless the Lord, all his works,  
in every place where he rules.

the Lord who gives sight to the blind,  
who raises up those who are bowed down,

the Lord, who protects the stranger  
and upholds the widow and orphan.

It is the Lord who loves the just  
but thwarts the path of the wicked.

The Lord will reign forever,  
Zion's God, from age to age.

### **Hymn of the Incarnation**

O only-begotten Son and Word of God, who, being immortal, deigned for our salvation to become incarnate of the holy Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary, and became man without change; you were also crucified, O Christ our God, and by death have trampled Death, being One of the Holy Trinity, glorified with the Father and the Holy Spirit, save us.

In your kingdom, remember us, O Lord, when you come in your kingdom.

(Tone 2) As the desert has flowered like a lily, so will the sterile church of the Gentiles

- O blessed Nicholas, true disciple of the Master, preserve those who have recourse to  
you from grievous dangers and bitter death.

- O God of many mercies, at the intercessions of your servant Nicholas, cleanse your  
servants; since you are good, grant them the forgiveness of their sins.

**5.** *Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness,  
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.*

- Calm the tumult of my passions, O Queen, and pilot my life, for you are the all-holy  
one who gave birth to Christ in which my heart exults.

**4.** *Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you  
and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me.*

(Tone 1) O Nicholas, you are like another Abraham, for you brought your Master the  
sacrifice of your mind, as an only-begotten son, perpetually offering it to him in a bloodless  
way. Blessed for your hospitality, O father, you became the dwelling-place of the Trinity.

**3. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven.**

- O Nicholas, you worked awesome wonders throughout the world and far out upon the sea;  
by your prayers you protect those in danger, heal the sick and feed the poor. As a worthy  
bearer of your name, you have made the faithful victorious over their enemies.

**2. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.**

- Seeing the future spiritually, you filled the world with true doctrine, teaching that the Son is  
of the same essence as the Father. You overthrew the folly of Arius and laid down your own  
instructions as a true pillar of orthodoxy

- Bowing the heavens as he wished, Christ came down to dwell in your womb, O all-holy  
Virgin. he could not bear to see the work of his hands under the rule of the Deceiver; so he  
came in the form of a servant to save us all.

### **Prokeimenon, Tone 7:**

The just man will rejoice in the Lord and will put his trust in him.

*Verse:* Hear my voice, O God, when I pray to you.

Epistle: Hebrews 13:17-21

*Leader:* A reading from the Second Letter of St. Paul the Apostle to the Hebrews.

Brothers and Sisters: Obey your leaders and defer to them, for they keep watch over you and

will have to give an account, that they may fulfill their task with joy and not with sorrow, for that would be of no advantage to you. Pray for us, for we are confident that we have a clear conscience, wishing to act rightly in every respect. I especially ask for your prayers that I may be restored to you very soon. May the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great shepherd of the sheep by the blood of the eternal covenant, Jesus our Lord, furnish you with all that is good, that you may do his will. May he carry out in you what is pleasing to him through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

**Alleluia, Tone 4:** Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia

*Verse:* Your priests will be clothed with righteousness and your saints will rejoice.

*Verse:* Happy the man who fears the Lord and greatly delights in his commands.

*Leader:* A reading from the gospel of the holy apostle and evangelist Luke. (Luke 6:17-23)

*Response:* Glory to you, O Lord, glory to you.

### **Profession of Faith**

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible; and in one Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, the only-begotten, born of the Father before all ages. Light from light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, one in essence with the Father; through whom all things were made. For us and for our salvation, he came down from heaven and was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary, and became man. He was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate, and suffered and was buried. He rose on the third day according to the scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he is coming again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end. And in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the Creator of Life, who proceeds from the Father. Together with the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified; he spoke through the prophets. In one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church. I profess one baptism for the remission of sins. I expect the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Remit, pardon, and forgive our transgressions, voluntary and involuntary, in deed and in word, with knowledge and in ignorance, in thought and in desire, by night and by day, forgive them all, O God, for you are good and love us all.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

*Leader:* Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us.

*Response:* Amen.

### **Kontakion, Tone 3:**

You were renowned as a priest in Myra, O holy Nicholas; for you fulfilled the Gospel of

Christ, O Venerable Father. You risked your life for your people and saved the innocent from death. Thereby you have been initiated into the mysteries of the grace of God.

Lord, have mercy. (*Twelve times*)

*Leader:* Most holy Trinity, Consubstantial Power, Indivisible Kingdom, Cause of all good things, look favorably upon me, a sinner, at this present hour. Take away all the defilement of my mind and enlighten my understanding that I may always praise, glorify, and say:

*Response:* One is holy, one is Lord Jesus Christ, to the glory of God the Father. Amen

*The Leader bows his head and together with the faithful makes a spiritual Communion praying aloud:*

O Lord, I believe and confess that you are truly Christ,  
who came into the world

To save sinners of whom I am the first.

*Although I cannot be a partaker now of your mystical supper, O Son of God,*  
Come at least spiritually into my heart by Your Divine Grace  
for the healing of my soul and body.

For I will not reveal your mystery to your enemies,

Nor will I give you a kiss as did Judas,

But like the thief I profess to you:

+ Remember me, O Lord, when you come in your kingdom.

+ Remember me, O Master, when you come in your kingdom.

+ Remember me, O Holy One, when you come in your kingdom.

O Lord, I also believe and profess, that this,

Which I would receive, and which is now here present with us in Mystery,  
Is truly your most precious Body, and your life-giving Blood,

Which, I pray, I may one day receive again

For the remission of all my sins and for life everlasting. Amen
