



Cantor: (*Tone 2*) If you, O Lord, should mark our guilt, Lord who would survive? But with you is found forgiveness: for this we revere you.


Stichera of the Theophany - Tone 2 samohlasen




Cantor: My soul is longing for the Lord. I count on his word.




Aposticha doxastikon of the Synaxis of the Forerunner - Tone 4 samohlasen

Theotokion - in the same tone





