


**Vesper Propers for the

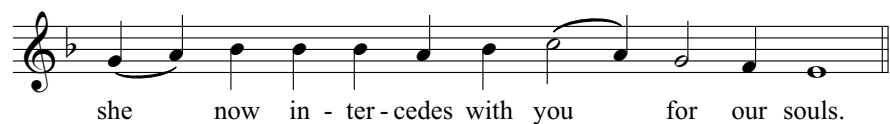
Dwell - ing in the des - ert, you put the images of the passions far from
