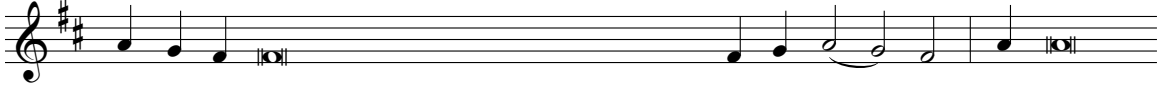
Entrance Hymn - Tone 1 Troparion (Psalm 117: 26, 27):
