



received your blessings in a - bun - dance. Be - hold my tears and strengthen me, O



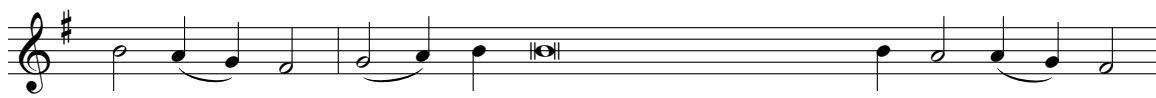
Christ our God, for you are in - deed the Lov - er of us all.

Cantor: Glory...

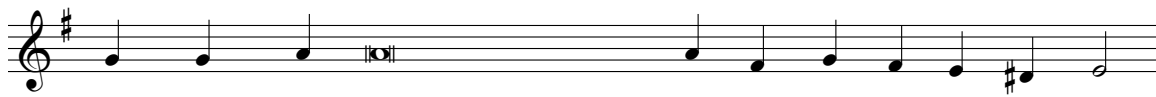

Num - ber me with them, O Lord, and have mer - cy on me.


