The holy martyr Paramon was martyred in Bithynia in Asia Minor along with 370 other Christians during the persecution of the governor Aquilinus. (250)

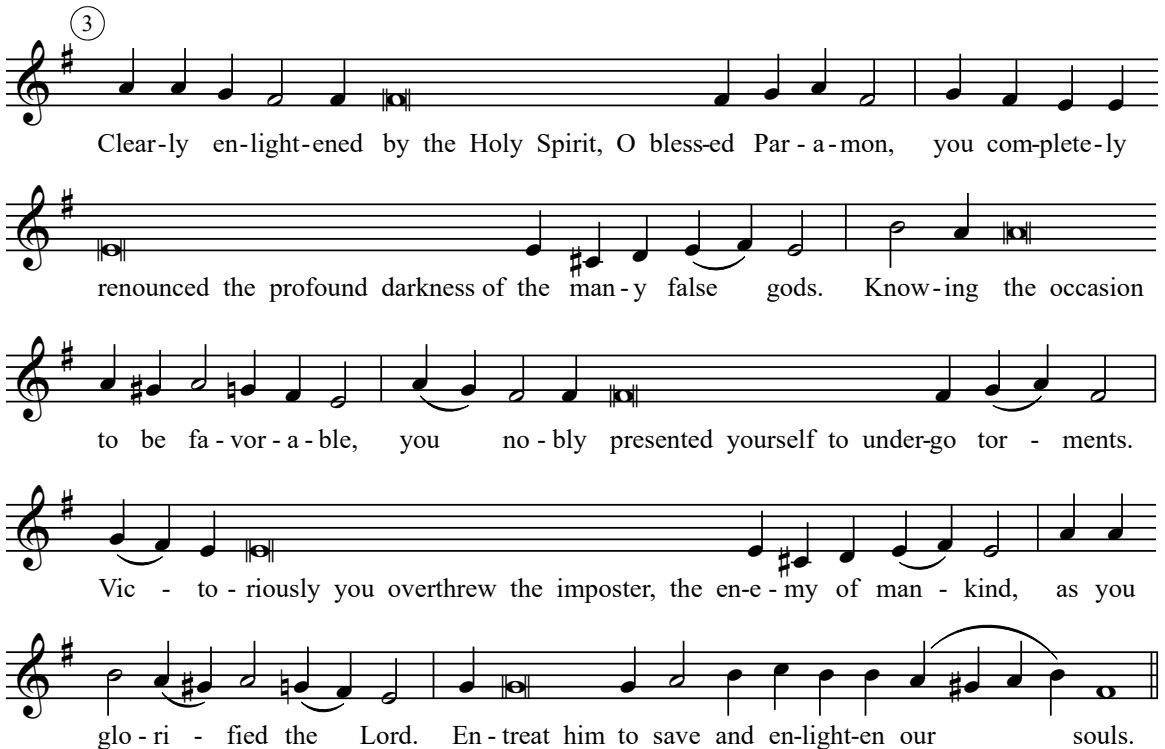

(on 3) Israel indeed he will redeem from all its iniquity.

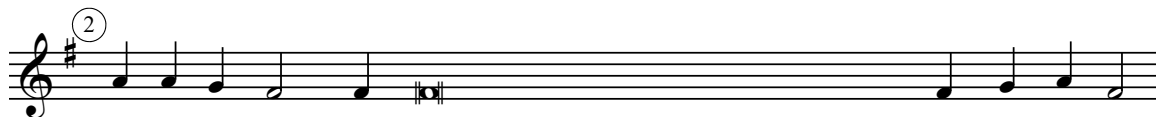

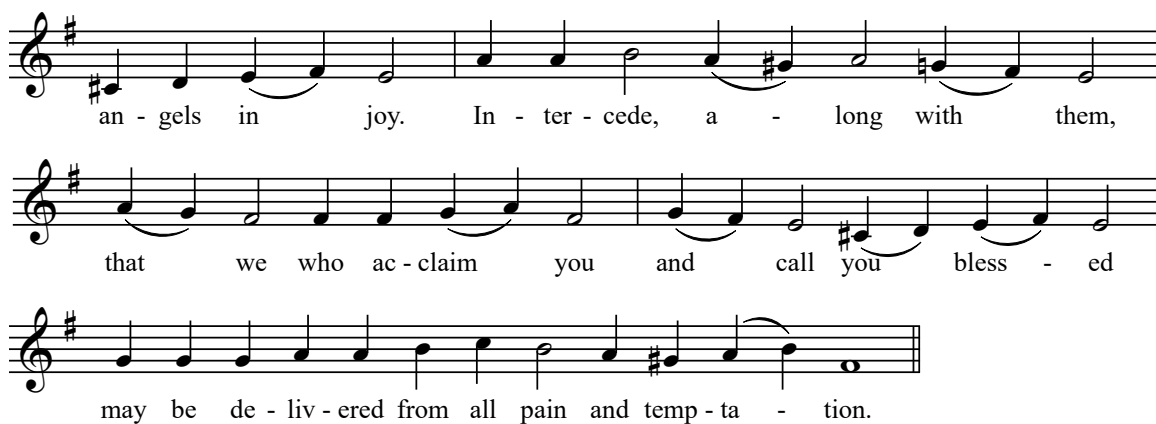
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Clear-ly en-light-ened by the Holy Spirit, O bless-ed Par - a-mon, you com-plete-ly
